# Requirements To Use Collection Centers



CAUTION should be used when transporting hazardous waste to a Collection Center due to the potential for spillage and/or exposure.

- A maximum of 15 gallons or 125 pounds may be transported at any one time per State regulations. It is illegal to exceed these limits.
- · Hazardous Waste should be in its original container.
- All containers must have lids, be sturdy, non-leaking and protected from breakage.
- · Containers larger than 5 gallon in size may not be accepted.
- Containers will NOT be returned, except for oil containers (upon request).
- · REMAIN IN VEHICLE when delivering waste to Center.
- DO NOT mix or combine Hazardous Waste.

Next to City of Irvine Corporate Yard & Bark Park. From the (5) freeway take the Sand Canyon exit, go southwest to Oak Canyon and turn right.

# SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO REGIONAL COLLECTION CENTER

#### PRIMA DESHECHA LANDFILL

From the (5) freeway take Ortega Hwy. (74), go East to La Pata Ave., turn right and follow road to Landfill entrance; or Antonio Pkwy. South past Ortega Hwy., continue on La Pata Ave. to Landfill entrance
